

From the very outset of the Fondation Maeght, Joan Miró gave free rein to his imagination and created a unique space in the world: The Miró Labyrinth. With his friends the Artigas, a father and son duo, who were ceramists, he created a magical place populated by monumental sculptures.

20 works made of ceramics, marble, bronze, iron, concrete were thus crafted by the artist and displayed in an unrivalled natural environment.

Now, more than 50 years after their creation, structural and cosmetic damage has been identified on some of them. In 2018, the three marble sculptures were restored and the Société des Amis will finance the restoration of two ceramic works, namely Gargouille and *L'Œuf* in 2019.

To preserve the Labyrinth, the Société des Amis of the Fondation Maeght has decided to launch a campaign to finance the restoration of 14 of its works. The Société des Amis demonstrates its strong commitment to artistic creation by proposing this project to the Fondation Maeght and helps to preserve the works in the Fondation Maeght's collection. It is in line with its missions.



REGARDLESS OF THE AMOUNT OF YOUR DONATION, YOU WILL BE ABLE TO BENEFIT FROM TAX ADVANTAGES

The Fondation Maeght, which is recognised as an organisation of public interest, is authorised to receive donations from you, and part of the donated amount will count towards reducing the amount of income tax you have to pay. It is also able to receive donations, a part of which can count towards reducing the amount of your Real Estate Tax (RET).

INCOME TAX (IT)

• FOR INDIVIDUALS

General scheme: tax reduction equal to 66% of the amount of the donation withheld up to a maximum of 20% of taxable income. Article 200 of the French General Tax Code a donation of $\notin 100 = \notin 34$ after tax reduction

• FOR COMPANIES

General scheme: tax reduction equal to 60% of the amount of the donation withheld within the limit of 5 per thousand of the turnover. Possibility of spreading the reduction over 5 years if the ceiling is exceeded. *Article 238 bis of the French General Tax Code a donation of* €1,000= €400 after tax deduction. The benefit of the tax reduction is exclusively reserved for taxpayers domiciled in France for tax purposes within the meaning of Articles 4A and 4B of the French General Tax Code.

PROPERTY WEALTH TAX (PWT)

Taxpayers subject to property wealth tax may benefit from a reduction in their PWT in the case of donations to certain non-profit-making public-interest organisations and foundations recognised as being of public benefit. This PWT reduction is equal to 75% of the amount of their payments and is capped at \in 50,000. Donations made in the year preceding the year of taxation are eligible for the PWT reduction.
